SOLE PROPRIETORS, PARTNERSHIPS, AND LIMITED LIABILITY CORPORATIONS

Workers' Compensation Law permits self-employed persons, partners of partnerships (other than limited partners) and members of limited liability companies (LLC's) to elect to be covered for benefits.

If you are self-employed (sole proprietor) or a partner as defined in Section 10 of the Partnership Law or a member of an LLC, you can elect to be covered under your policy by completing, signing and returning to Agri-Services Agency, LLC, along with this letter, the enclosed Notice of Election form, U-627. Coverage would take effect one day after the date postmarked on the envelope in which your election is received.

Premium of this coverage would be subject to a minimum and maximum annual remuneration. Effective October 1, 2007, the minimum remuneration is \$28,600 and the maximum remuneration is \$84,500 annually.

If you have no employees and you do not want coverage for yourself (if self-employed) or for any partner (if partnership) or for any member of an LLC, you can avoid premium charges by canceling your policy. Cancellation can be effected by sending us written notice.
